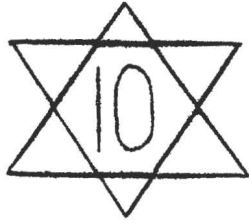
Within 48 hours contributions jumped 20% in appreciation of our profound concern for our President's recovery. Thank God!

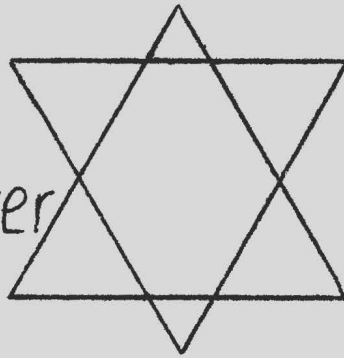
